# Casa del Sol Naciente A-Z

In our effort to make it easy for you to access the services and amenities designed to make your experience at *Casa del Sol Naciente* truly memorable, we have created this guide. Should you require any further assistance, or you have any questions that extend beyond what you may find in this guide, please contact us directly and we will do our best to help you further.

## **10 Miles per Hour**

The speed limit throughout the Cabo Bello community is 10 miles per hour. Please follow the speed limit at all times to respect other residents of the community.

## **A**

### **Airport Transportation**

Transportation to the airport is available via a few different options. The options we recommend include:

**Rental Car:** Rental cars are great if you intend on driving around and visiting places during your stay. This will be much less expensive than any other form of transportation. Just make sure to purchase the insurance with the car.

**Taxi Van:** Taxi vans are perhaps the most commonly used transportation in Cabo San Lucas as they are fast and direct. They will hold about 8 passengers so they are great for large groups. On average, these should cost about \$60-80 US to get from the Airport to *Casa del Sol Naciente* and vice versa. Taking taxi's to/from town and to/from *Casa del Sol Naciente* you should expect to pay around \$25 USD each way.

**Shuttle Van:** This is the best mode of transportation to get to/from *Casa del Sol Naciente* to/from the Airport if you have a small group. The shuttle costs should be around \$15 US per person. You can find the shuttle outside the airport to the right. Look for the White vans.

**Uber:** The newest transportation to hit Cabo. Uber is just like home, and is by far the cheapest option. We have had mixed reviews. However, it is becoming more popular among guests and locals.

### **Air Conditioning**

There are A/C units located throughout the home. The A/C here in Cabo is very expensive to operate, so please, when the units are on, make sure you have all windows and doors closed. These units have been preset to the most efficient setting and we ask that you do not adjust them.

If you are leaving the home for the day, or long periods of time, please turn the units OFF.

## **Activities**

In Cabo San Lucas, there are many different activities to experience while visiting. Below are some of our recommended activities:

**Cabo Dolphins:** Perhaps one of the best experiences of your lifetime. Bring the whole family and get up close and personal with the bottlenose dolphins. Heck, if you feel like it, jump in and take a swim with them! You will find Cabo Dolphins on the marina boardwalk.

**Cabo Flyboard:** Have you ever dreamed about flying like superman or maybe swimming like a dolphin? Dreams can come true in Cabo! The Flyboard is a device connected to your feet and powered by a personal watercraft, which allows propulsion underwater and in the air. Users are connected to the board by wakeboard boots, under which, water pressure provides thrust. A certified trainer controls the power and height and you control all the movement. Available at Medano beach, or online, for bookings. This activity is a must, while visiting Cabo. Make your reservations and get flying today!

**Charter Fishing:** If you're the fishing type, then you need to partake in some of the best fishing in the world, while in Cabo. Charters can be found on the marina, and if you ask around you will find some better than others. Depending on the time of year you are visiting, you will find many different types of fish to catch. You can book half or full day trips, which you can expect to pay \$250-\$400 per person.

**Megdalena Bay Whales:** Climb on board and experience the majestic grey whales of the Baja waters. This is a thrilling 6 hour whale, dolphin, and bird watching tour. Explore La Isla, a secluded island on the Pacific Ocean, where you'll greet some of the last fisherman of Baja California Peninsula, learn & soak up on culture, and experience a unique way of lifestyle. Hike and photograph the magnificent sand-dunes as you look for some of the most beautiful sea shells on the bay. Although, it is the annual migration of the grey whales that come down to the warmer waters to give birth and raise their young that truly captivates.

**Paddle Boarding:** There is something special about paddling out and finding yourself floating in the ocean with just a paddle and a board. Paddle boarding is a great way to see marine life and to get a great workout, while enjoying nature. At Medano beach, you can rent boards in several locations.

Certain companies offer lessons and some even have yoga classes on the boards!

**Snorkeling:** Snorkeling is such a great activity to do with family and friends while in Cabo. There are many different snorkeling charters, and all of them are very similar in price and experience. The unique fish home to the Cabo area are amazingly beautiful to see and swim with. If you're lucky you may even see turtles. Vendors can be found on the marina or Medano beach.

## B

### **Beaches**

One of the best things about Cabo is the vast amount of beautiful beaches that have so much to offer. We love all these beaches, so you can't go wrong going to any of them!

**Cabo Bello Beach:** a couple minute walk from *Casa del Sol Naciente*. This beach is private to the community of Cabo Bello so you will find it much quieter and relaxing. There is a slight current here, but snorkeling is possible for intermediate to experienced swimmers.

**Chileno Beach:** This beach is perhaps one of the most popular diving and snorkeling beaches in

Cabo San Lucas. A 10-15 minute taxi ride north of *Casa del Sol Naciente*, along the corridor, swimming conditions are excellent here thanks to Chileno Bay. The water has perfect visibility for observing the sea life below. Just beware of touching the rocks as you can get in contact with barnacles.

**Medano Beach:** If you're looking for the action, here it is. El Medano (as the locals call it) is a 2-mile stretch of hotels, restaurants and bars, right on the sand. It's a swimmable and family-friendly beach with endless options for souvenir shopping. Numerous activities and watersports are available. If you want to take a water taxi to Lover's Beach, this is the best spot to do it. Its stunning view of Land's End and the vast entertainment options make this beach a must see.

**Tip:** Be prepared to be approached by souvenir vendors. If you're not there for the shopping, just respond with "No, Gracias." Prices don't vary much from one water sport rental place to another, but you still have bargaining power. Visit Lover's Beach while you are here.

**Lover's Beach:** Getting here is an adventure in itself, due to the fact that it is reachable only by boat or kayak. The easiest way is to take a water taxi from the Cabo San Lucas Marina or Medano Beach. Prices are around \$15 US per person. Ask your captain to

cruise by the arch and sea lion rock for some great photo opportunities. Once you arrive you'll notice the striking rock formations and caves. Walk to the other side of the rocks and you'll find yourself looking at the Pacific Ocean; the locals call this Divorce Beach. This side is very dangerous for swimming because of the powerful undertow, so swim on Lover's Beach side only.

**Tip:** There are a couple vendors who offer beer and water, but you will not find any other services. A good idea is to spend the day at Medano Beach and take an hour or two to go to Lover's Beach; this should be enough time to explore this wonderland.

**Santa Maria Beach:** Located at KM 11.5 off of the main highway, this horseshoe shaped beach is just plain beautiful. Part of a marine sanctuary, this beach offers outstanding opportunities for swimming and snorkeling and getting up close to myriad tropical fish. For a special treat, bring some bread or tortillas and hand feed the fish! As this is a marine sanctuary, the taking of fish is not allowed. There are a few vendors that travel to this beach, but it is best to bring what you need with you. One of the great features of this beach is the pinkish colored sand that is about the size of a kernel of rice and not irritating like fine sand. Bring cameras, this place is a photographer's dream. Take only photos, leave only footprints!

**Widow's Beach:** Located at KM 11 off of the main highway, this beach is a favorite of those seeking seclusion. With many coves and unique volcanic rock formations, it's easy to find a private spot, even when there are many people here. Swimming is safe, snorkeling is great and excellent tide pools make this a must visit beach.

### **Beach Equipment**

We provide our guests with everything you will need to spend the day at the beach. As we supply these items for your use we ask that when you are done with them, please rinse off and properly clean any beach equipment so the next guest will be able to enjoy them as well.

### **Checkout**

Checkout is at 11:00AM. Upon checkout we ask that you help our staff by stripping all used bedding and used towels and placing them in the laundry baskets provided in each room. As well, please wash and clean any dishes you have used and put away in the correct locations. We would love if you would take a moment and tells us how your stay went.

## D

### **Dining & Drinks**

Cabo San Lucas offers amazing restaurants and bars that are a must visit during your stay. Below are the ones that we have found to be some local favorites.

**ALEXANDERS:** Located on the marina, this is one of our go to spots while downtown. Serving breakfast, lunch and dinner you really can't go wrong here. Great food, entertainment and marina views right in the heart of downtown Cabo.

**BAJA BREWING:** Baja Brewing opened its doors in 2007 as the first brewery in the state of Baja California Sur, where the idea was to create delicious craft brews for locals and visitors to enjoy. Located on both the marina and the rooftop of Cabo Villas Beach Resort, this is a visit for your craft beer needs.

**EL FARALON:** This is one of a kind dining in Mexico. Built along the cliffs at The Resort at Pedregal, waves crash so close to the tables you can sometimes feel the spray, and you might even see a crab or two clamor up to the patio from the rocks

below. Known as a romance spot, this is actually a fairly casual restaurant, with a unique tasting menu focus featuring fresh, locally caught seafood. Be sure to stop at the new champagne bar for a flight of bubbly.

**MARIA JIMENEZ:** A lot of people will tell you to go to Edith's in Cabo San Lucas, a colorful, lively tourist-filled spot for huge plates of enchiladas, steaks and bananas foster. And it's good. But Maria Jimenez is where the locals will tell you to go instead. A little north off the main tourist area, this family-run spot is intimate and homey, a must-visit for anyone who likes to get off the beaten path. Portions are generous, the margaritas are fantastic, and you'll leave knowing it's the first place you'll go when you're in Cabo next. Cash only.

**NO BAD DAYS/LATITUDE 22:** Located within a short taxi ride from *Casa del Sol Naciente* Latitude 22 is a great place with amazing memorabilia and is a must check out while visiting.

**SUNSET DE MONA LISA:** This place is perfect for couples who wish to dine with amazing views of the Sea of Cortez. Definitely a must visit if you are looking for a romantic dinner. We prefer sunset as this is the best time to go, but be sure to make reservations as it can book up fast.

**SUNSET POINT WINE & PIZZA BAR:** Located right above the Sunset De Mona Lisa. Sunset point wine and pizza bar offers less expensive meals and drinks with the best view in Cabo San Lucas.

**THE OFFICE ON THE BEACH:** If only this was our office. The name says it all about this popular Cabo San Lucas restaurant: it is indeed on the beach, with most of the tables in the sand. The food is pretty basic Mexican fare-tostadas, seafood cocktails, grilled panela cheese with tomatoes- but there are big local crabs steamed with garlic and butter that make it worth your while. They are open for breakfast, lunch and dinner, and there's usually live entertainment.

**WTF BURGER:** Located right on the marina, WTF Burger brings a little Las Vegas flair to your dining experience in Cabo. They import the finest beef and all of their products from the US in order to maintain a consistent high quality standard. The main goal at WTF is for all to enjoy the classic American cuisine at affordable prices. Menu incorporates classic American with a little Cabo twist.

### **Doctor/Hospital**

In the event you need to see a doctor or go to the hospital. Blue Medical Center is located in the

building complex in front of Cabo Bello. This is a full service medical center.

### **Garbage Service**

The main garbage bins are located outside to the right of the parking pergola along the wall behind the stick doors. All garbage can be placed in these bins. Garbage service comes Monday, Wednesday and Friday. If you are staying during these times we ask that you put the trash cans out near the street for the garbage man to pick up on these days.

## **Groceries**

There are several grocery stores close to *Casa del Sol Naciente*. We have put together a list of those that are close by for your ease.

**COSTCO**: Located a couple miles down the road headed towards Cabo. Very similar to the ones in the US and accepts US Costco Cards. Stock up here on food and supplies for your trip if you please.

**WAL-MART**: Located about a mile or so past Costco. Very similar to the Wal-Mart's in the US. If you don't plan on doing bulk shopping this is a great place to get supplies you will need for the trip.

**SANTA CARMELA MARKET**: Located just a mile from *Casa del Sol Naciente* near Home Depot, Santa Carmela is a great little market for missed items and offers organic Mexican and American products. They feature a nice selection of miscellaneous cooking and household needs.

## **Grocery Delivery**

If you're the type that doesn't want to spend your vacation shopping for groceries we have you covered! Two great services can do it for you and have everything at the home on your arrival.

**CABO KRUZER**: Whether you order before you arrive or during your stay, Cabo Kruzer will make

your vacation that much easier. One great perk is Cabo Kruzer hosts private tequila tastings with some of Mexico's finest tequilas for groups of 8 or more! Let them do the shopping so you don't have to!

***PRICKLY PEAR:*** Prickly Pear like Cabo Kruzer is another great delivery service. They have the simple goal of making the shopping one less thing to worry about. Easy to navigate website lets you relax and do the work for you!

You can find many authentic Mexican items for family and friend's downtown or walk Medano Beach and purchase from the vendors. Remember you have bargaining power here in Mexico so always try to get the best deal you can.

*Casa del Sol Naciente* has two pools. Both are located on the front patio and are maintained by a professional. Maintenance will show up periodically to check on the pools. The pool is heated and set to 82 degrees in order to preserve on gas for the home.

## **Surfing**

Cabo San Lucas offers great surfing spots for those that enjoy the sport. We have compiled a list of a few beaches that are great for surfing. If you plan to surf, check out these beaches.

**Old Man's Beach:** If surfing is your thing, don't miss Playa Acapulquito just off the highway before the lookout at KM 27.5. A surf school and restaurant make this small beach popular with the local surf



crowd. Acapulquito also offers good swimming during calm seasons.

**Playa Costa Azul:** Located through the arroyo at Costa Azul Bridge, at KM 29 off the main highway, this is home of world famous Zippers and La Roca surf breaks. Swimming is risky and only recommended for surfers. Many surfing competitions take place here every year. Nearby Costa Azul Surf Shop has surfboard rentals, dining is near at Zipper's restaurant and there is also a convenience store close by. This beach is a great place to surf or to watch others surf.

## T

### **Taxi Service**

Taxes are available 24 hours a day upon request. You will need to call the Cabo Bello security gate to request a taxi pick up. Typically it takes about 10-20 minutes for one to arrive so plan ahead.

## W

### **Water Jugs**

We provide two water jugs that have clean water that is safe to drink. If during your stay you run out you can take the empty jug to the OXXO store (mini-

mart) or Santa Carmela Market and purchase a new one. These will save you from having to buy individual water bottles.

If you cannot get the jug to the OXXO store or Santa Carmela Market please let us know and we will do what we can to get you a new one at an additional charge.
